MA, Capt. Brackett was taken ill & d. in Ipswich, MA on his way home. [Highlights of Westbrook History]
- BRACKETT, JOHN SNOW** b. NOV 23, 1749 in FALMOUTH, ME; m. BETSEY BERRY; d. 1801 in WESTBROOK, ME
- BRACKETT, JOSHUA, SR., CAPT** b. JUN 7, 1723 in FALMOUTH, ME; m. ESTHER COX on DEC 9, 1744 d. 1816 in
WESTBROOK, ME; s/o Zachariah; wife d/o John Cox; He was Capt. Of company of Minutemen & marched with them
to Cambridge in 1775. [Portland Evening Express June 27, 1914.]
- BRACKETT, JOSHUA, JR.** b. JUL 31, 1767; m. LYDIA HASTY(?) d. Jun 10, 1849; Pvt; as recorded here, he was too young to
have been in service in 1775 [DAR Patriots Index]
- BRACKETT, JOSIAH** b. 1757 d. Aug 8, 1820; bur on farm of Willis H. Leighton (W. Falmouth); listed from WESTBROOK, ME
Buried in neighborhood Cem on farm of Willis H. Leighton. Pensioner, was supported by the town. No headstone
- BRACKETT, SAMUEL** b. ABT 1756 in WESTBROOK, ME; d. Jun 30, 1778 in service
- BRACKETT, WILLIAM, SGT.** b. AUG 9, 1752; m. (1) BETSEY WALKER on NOV 14, 1782
(2) JUDITH SMITH on JUN 23, 1825; d. Nov 10, 1846; buried in Knight cemetery in WESTBROOK, ME;
supposed to be buried in Westbrook; died in Westbrook; Pensioner; went with son Thomas to Westbrook about 1845 [no
stone found in 2003]
- COBB, PETER** b. Dec 18, 1754 in FALMOUTH, ME; m. Margaret Crandall abt 1780; d. Apr 1827; bur Rocky Hill Cemetery
WESTBROOK, ME; Cpl. Mass; supposed buried on "Cobbe Griggs Place, Rocky Hill". No grave/cemetery found in 2003;
In Samuel Knight's Co. 1776; s/o Peter b. 1720 in Falmouth; grands/o Samuel 14th settler of Falmouth [Me His. & Gen.
Recorder Vol3] [dates rec'd as 1764-1824 in 1 source]
- CURTIS, JOSEPH** b. Apr 3, 1747; m. Hannah Benson ; d. Dec 11, 1823; from WESTBROOK, ME; Pvt. Mass [DAR Patriots Index]
- CURTISS, JOSEPH** b. Dec 22, 1721 ; m. Abigail Baldwin; d. Oct 1791; from WESTBROOK, ME; Maj. Mass; Faithfully served the US
6 yrs disch June 10, 1783; thought to be a member of Lunt family in Westbrook. [Portland Evening Express, June 27, 1914]
- ELLIOT, JACOB** b. Apr 4, 1764 in FALMOUTH or WINDHAM, ME; n. Ann Baker Nov 25, 1787; d. Oct 15, 1849;
- FOSS, JOSEPH** b. abt 1762 in SACO, ME; d. Apr 6, 1848
- HARDY, WILLIAM** b. Feb 12, 1758; m. Mary Hyde; d. Nov 19, 1852; Pvt. Mass; no record has been found [DAR Patriots Index]

- JOHNSON, JOHN** b. May 14, 1737 in STROUDWATER, ME; m. Eleanor Lamb; D. May 28, 1833, WESTBROOK, ME;

LEWIS, ARCHELAUS b. Jul 15, 1753 in BERWICK, ME; m. (1) Rebechah Hubbard (2) Elizabeth (Eliza) Brown (3) Frances Angier; d. Jan 2/21, 1834; b. Stroudwater Cemetery, PORTLAND, ME; Settled in Saccarappa in 1774 & opened a tailor shop; 1776 entered Continental Army & served 5 yrs; Was with Washington's Army at Valley Forge & held commission of Lt.; Uncle Francis Lewis was a signer of Declaration of Independence [*History of Cumberland Co.*, p 384]

LUNT, DANIEL, CAPT. b. Nov 19, 1749 in KITTERY, ME (?); m. (1) Molly Frink or Starbuck (2) Eunice Conant on Jan 7, 1790; d. Nov 27, 1823; bur May Farm, Brook Street, WESTBROOK, ME; s/o Samuel Lunt who came from Kittery abt 1760; Daniel settled on farm in Westbrook formerly owned & occupied by Daniel Colley; "buried on May farm cemetery"; [Foot stone only, DL, found in small cemetery behind 6 Lunt DR in 2003. Brother has stone there] [more info on Daniel *Portland Evening Express*, June 29, 1914, pg 8]

MARCH, PELETIAH b. abt 1740; m. Mary Fabyan Brackett in 1776; d. abt 1813 in FALMOUTH (now WESTBROOK, ME)

MAYBERRY, THOMAS m. Sarah Quinby Nov 19, 1799; d. Jun 12, 1840, WESTBROOK, ME

MEANS, JAMES, MAJ. WESTBROOK, ME; no record in DAR Patriots Index; lived in lg brick house across Westbrook St from the Tate House

MINOT, THOMAS, CAPT. b. 1740; d. 1822, WESTBROOK, ME

PARTRIDGE, JESSE, CAPT. d. abt 1742; m. Keziah Clapp; d. Dec 21, 1795; bur Stroudwater Cemetery, PORTLAND, ME; He was a land owner in Westbrook by the river (Stroudwater) [*Portland Evening Express* May 29, 1914]

PRATT, CUSHING bur Woodlawn Cemetery (?), WESTBROOK, ME; NO record in DAR Patriots Index; The Pratt farm on Stroudwater St. is now (1976) occupied by Mrs. Doris Greenlaw DeWolfe. It is probably one of the oldest houses in Westbrook (1765) [House demolished 2008] [no stone found in Woodlawn in 2003; there is a Cushing Pratt in Saccarappa Cemetery by he was b. 1794]

PRIDE, JOHN C. b. 1762; m. Phebe Porter; d. Apr 9, 1832; may be 2nd s/o Capt. Joseph Sr.; Sgt. Mass; ?also listed as John A., Pvt in Samuel Knight's Co Nov 1776 [*ME His & Gen Recorder* V3, p210]

PRIDE, JOSEPH, CAPT. b. Apr 12, 1726 in FALMOUTH, ME; m. Hannah Knight; d. Dec 3, 1810; In Capt. Samuel Knight's Co. of Nov 1776 [*Me His. & gen. Recorder* V3, p210] Commanded a company whose duty was to coast along the shore & protect fishermen & other small craft from British privateers. His 2 sons served in his company [Highlights of Westbrook History] lived near E. Bridge St by Pride's Bridge; ancestor of all the Prides in Westbrook vicinity.

PRIDE, JOSEPH, JR. b. Oct 19, 1755 in WESTBROOK, ME; m. Mary Knight; d. Dec 4, 1843; bur Bailey Cemetery, Forest Ave, PORTLAND, ME; Of Pride's Corner; pensioned

PRIDE, PETER b. May 12, 1746; m. Elizabeth Thissell; D. Jan 5, 1820; Pvt. Mass; may be 2nd s/o Capt. Joseph, Sr.

QUIMBY, BENJAMIN b. Sep 15, 1746 in SOMERWOTH, NH; m. Lydia Clements; d. Nov 6, 1810; bur in west corner Saccarappa Cemetery, WESTBROOK, ME; s/o Benjamin

QUIMBY, JOSEPH b. in WESTBROOK, ME; m. Mary ___; d. Apr 14, 1776; bur Stroudwater Cemetery, PORTLAND, ME;

QUINBY, JOSEPH, PVT. B. Jul 1, 1750 in SOMERWORTH, NH; m. Azubah Partridge; D. Apr 1797; bur Quinby Lot, Saccarappa Cemetery, WESTBROOK, ME; Headstone

SAWYER, JOHN WESTBROOK, ME; listed as pensioner [*Sprague*, 8-pg 164]

SAWYER, THOMAS b. Jul 11, 1758 in FALMOUTH, ME; m. Mary Davis; d. Apr 11, 1833

SKILLIN, SIMEON b. Dec 17, 1747 in SCARBORO, ME; m. Mary Skillin; d. Jan 2, 1804; bur in middle of great field of Westbrook St, SO. PORTLAND, ME; s/o Howard & Sarah (Mills); thought once to have been a resident of Westbrook

SMALL, JEREMIAH, PVT. b. Apr 15, 1750 in FALMOUTH, ME; m. Jerusha Woodbury Dec 19, 1776; d. Aug 30, 1846; bur in family plot near Highland Lake, WESTBROOK, ME; Buried on farm he owned in family cemetery near Highland Lake. There is now a "In Memorandum..." stone for both he & wife in Highland Lake Cemetery...no dates on stones.

STARBIRD, JOHN b. abt 1756; m. Chole Bradford; d. Nov 1, 1829; bur Woodlawn Cemetery, WESTBROOK, ME; Headstone. Ensign Vose's Reg't; Starbird's farm is now part of Woodlawn Cem;

STEVENS, JOSHUA B. Oct 28, 1743 in FALMOUTH, ME; m. Susannah Sawyer; d. May 7, 1800

STORER, JOSEPH, COL. b. abt 1744; m. Joanna Greaves (Graves); d. Oct 23, 1777; d. FISHKILL, NY; Buried in Albany, NY where he died. Source states age as 51, ? b. 1726

WAKEFIELD, GIBBONS b. Mar 7, 1727 in WELLS, ME; m. Nancy Jellison Mar 19, 1789; d. Mar 14, 1807, WESTBROOK, ME

WARREN, DAVID b. Nov 17, 1760 in WESTBROOK, ME; m. Mary Knight 1787; D. Aug 8, 1847; bur Richer-Berry Cemetery, BUCKFIELD, ME; Headstone. Cemetery enclosed by a wall.

WARREN, JOHN, PVT. b. Mar 3, 1731 in BERWICK, ME; m. Jane Johnson abt 1755; D. Jan 30, 1807; bur Saccarappa Cemetery, WESTBROOK, ME; Headstone. Pvt Brackett's Co 31 Mass Regt.

WARREN, JOHN b. Nov 9, 1756 in WESTBROOK, ME; D. May 23, 1776 in service; according to Westbrook Veteran list: buried Percy Knight farm, Congress St.; Pvt Capt. John Brackett's Co, Col. Edmund Phinney's 31st Regt May - Sep 1775; no burial site found 2003

WEBB, JAMES, SGT. b. abt 1750 in WESTBROOK, ME; m. (1) Nancy Conney (2) Mary Thomas Peakes; d. Sep 1, 1825; bur Conant Family Burial Grounds, WESTBROOK, ME; *Portland Advertiser* Sep 6, 1825: "Died, Col. James Webb of Falmouth, aged 72 yrs. He served through the whole of the Revolutionary War & as an ensign bore the standard at Monmouth NJ in one of the severest battles of the Revolutionary War." [some sources list him as buried on the Percy Knight farm on Rt 22 at Westbrook-Scarboro line but there is a stone for him at Conant Cemetery: "Sgt 1 Mass Mil., Rev War";] probably grands/o Samuel Webb
