

Grant Family Cemetery

Location: When heading from Westbrook, drive about 2 miles on Cumberland St. Take the dirt road on right, just after the school bus turn-a-round and before 855 Cumberland Street. Cemetery is half way up the road and in the woods on the right; it is behind the golf course.



Cemetery was found in the 1990s and one stone was recorded by Karen Ketover for her book *Westbrook, Maine Cemeteries*. In 2002, thanks to the help of Ken Moody and his wife Janet Grant Moody, we located the site and excavated and reset seven other stones, which had been buried under layers of dirt.
